

- 2. ENTRIES must be submitted on the printed entry form enclosed with the schedule TOGETHER WITH ENTRY FEES to reach the Secretary before midnight on 4<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.
- 3. The Society reserves the right to cancel any Section if only two exhibitors or less have entered at the time stated in Rule 3.
- 4. The Society reserves the right to cancel the Show in the event of the weather being such that it would be unreasonable to ask exhibitors to subject their exhibits to the conditions prevailing on the day. Applications for refunds must be received within 5 days, but the Society cannot accept responsibility for any expenses incurred by the exhibitors.
- 5. All exhibitor are to ensure their animals are correctly identified at the show, equine exhibitors are advised to have their passports with them at the show for inspection.
- 6. All exhibits to be on the Show ground by 9.00 a.m. on the day of the Show.
